The AUA Office of Research is offering travel award funding to subsidize meeting registration, travel and lodging costs associated with attendance to the 2019 StoneLab Scientific Symposium on December 6-7, 2019 at AUA Headquarters in Linthicum, MD. Travel award recipients will book their own travel and hotel accommodations. <u>All travel awardees will be expected to present a poster of their work during a poster session</u> during the meeting.

The deadline to apply is Monday, September 13, 2019 at 11:59 PM Eastern.

**REVIEW PROCESS.** A panel of reviewers will evaluate the merit of each application and the Director of Research will make the final funding decisions. All applicants will be notified of a decision no later than Monday, October 7, 2019.
